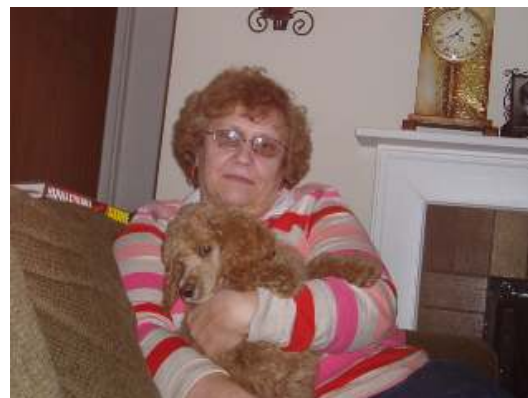

Poodelicious.....

PINK POODLE CAKE.....assembled entirely from two round cakes

Ingredients

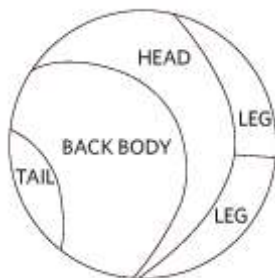
- 2 (9-inch round) cakes
- 3-1/2 cups pink frosting
- 1 pound sweetened coconut, tinted pink
- 1 large S-shaped cookie (Stella D'oro brand)
- Blue and red fruit leather
- 1 malted milk ball



Instructions

Cut and assemble the cake as shown. Use your hands to press the tail piece into a ball. Spoon 3 tablespoons of frosting into a ziplock bag and set it aside. Frost the entire cake, then sprinkle coconut fur on the poodle's body, ankles, head, and tail puff. Snip off a corner of the ziplock bag and pipe the tail.

Frost the cookie ear and set it in place. Snip eyelashes and a tongue from blue and red fruit leather and press them in place. Add the malted milk ball nose and a candy collar.

PRACTICAL POODLE POSTSCRIPT.....

GROWING PAINS.....



Between the ages of 6 and 18 months, many dogs are given up because owners can't handle their behavior.

Here is what to expect– and owner survival strategies.....

Chewing Items Around The House.

Dog Instinct: It can be painful for pups when their adult teeth grow in, so they gnaw to alleviate the ache.

Survival Strategy: If your puppy is chewing on off limit items, distract them with a loud noise and give them an alternative. Raw carrots cold from the refrigerator, chew toys. When no one is at home keep your puppy in a safe puppy proof area.

Digging in the Backyard.

Dog Instinct: Your puppy is bored.

Survival Strategy: To prevent your puppy from excavating your yard....create a sandbox or pit where it is okay to play. Bury treats in the sand. Praise your puppy when it digs in that area. Remember dogs look for cool dirt to lay in to beat the heat. Provide shady spots outside for your puppy to relax in on hot days.

Nipping and Jumping on you

Dog Instinct: watch how puppies play. Is your puppy submitting you to litter play?

Survival Strategy: While your puppy's actions may seem aggressive, he is just being playful. Ask your puppy to sit before giving it hugs & kisses. Make sure your puppy is getting enough exercise. Puppies need to have time to run and play so they can expend their energy.

Peeing Indoors

Dog Instinct: sometimes around 6 months of age your puppy may regress in house training. Hormones kick in and dogs may begin to mark their environment to let other animals know what is theirs.

Survival Strategy: If your puppy has started peeing indoors after being house trained, try to find out what is triggering this behavior– being left alone, changes to his/her environment, new pets in the home? Dogs are also less likely to urine mark if they are spayed or neutered.
