## THERAPY ACTIVITIES .....

#### **Animal Assisted Therapy**

I would like to announce a project of mine that has been in the works for about a year. I have started a new business in the worst of economic times.

It is called **PAWSitive Animal Therapy LLC**. I have a website at.... **pawsitiveanimaltherapy.com**. Here is my **Buddy** enjoying being read to



I will be giving a presentation to the CT Mental Health Counselors Association on November 12 about animal therapy. In doing research for my presentation, something I already knew solidified in my mind. Animal Assisted Activities are different from Animal Assisted Therapy. This may be of interest to those of you who dabble in this field with your poodles. Animal assisted activities (AAA) involve volunteers who take their pets to visit hospitals, nursing homes, day care programs, and many other types of facilities for the purpose of being petted & socializing with the residents/clients. Health care professionals or certified therapists who use their animal, or work in partnership with a volunteer and the volunteer's pet, using the pet as a treatment modality in a written, individualized treatment plan with specific, documented goals are performing Animal-Assisted Therapy (AAT).(Carol Ouhl, Caring Critters of Minnesota, Inc.).

I started out in **AAA** by volunteering with the dogs at a nursing home, but I have progressed to **AAT** at school where I work with the teachers and other professionals to set goals for some of our students with problems. I still do the reading therapy which is AAA. (see photo above). I guess I am fluctuating back and forth.

Part of the reason I started my business, which might be good for you to know, is to be covered by insurance when I bring my dogs to work. The organizations which certify therapy dogs only provide insurance coverage for volunteer activities. I have taught Buddy to stop, drop, and roll and I have made him a flame cape. He will be demonstrating his new found skills at school next week for Fire Prevention Week. I will read fire-themed stories to students in the library and Buddy will demonstrate the proper response if you or your clothes catch on fire. I could not do this if I did not have my own insurance as I will be working that day at my library job. I would also like to hire myself out to other professionals who would like to incorporate AAT into their practices, thus my presentation to the mental health counselors of CT.



## PRACTICAL POODLE POSTSCRIPT.....

#### Fall Poodle Tips.....

We don't usually associate the Fall season with hazards to our health or the health of our poodles. Most of us look forward to this invigorating, busy and active time of year. Who would imagine that a hike in the woods or meadows on a cool crisp, autumn day might produce potential harm to them via rodents, fleas, ticks, snakes or mushrooms.



Mushrooms that grow during the spring and fall, are attractive to the eye and yet can be very poisonous. Poisonous mushrooms can cause a range of health issues. Gastroenteritis, severe hallucinations and can even prove fatal if ingested. Contact your veterinarian immediately if your poodle has eaten a wild mushroom.

During the fall, rodents search for shelter from the cold weather. They build nests and may attempt to enter our homes for warmth and comfort. Be careful if using rodenticides around the house, the garage, and back yard. They are highly toxic to pets and cause bleeding disorders that can be deadly. You may wish to consider using live traps rather than a rodenticide to solve a rodent problem.

Snakes can also be a fall related hazard to your poodle's health. As they prepare to hibernate for the winter, they may be found unexpectedly by your pet. Be familiar with the various types of venomous snakes that live in your area and where they are generally located at this time of year. Then AVOID these areas!

Fall brings back to school time, make sure your children's school supplies, (pens, magic markers, paints, glue and glue guns, etc). are out of your poodle's reach. They can cause digestive and intestinal problems if consumed.

You may need to increase the caloric intake of your poodle in colder weather. During the heat of summer, pet's eat less. However, in the cooler months your poodle may need to generate more body heat to keep him warm. Also always provide your poodles with an abundance of cool and clean water to make sure that they remain hydrated. Check outdoor water bowls frequently and also make SURE the water has not frozen.

If you are preparing your car for the colder winter weather and are changing the engine coolant, be aware that many coolant products contain a chemical called Ethylene Gly-col that is highly toxic to your poodle. Check the ingredients and make sure you use a pet friendly and safe coolant product. Clean up any spillage of a coolant product so that your poodle can't find and lick it up!

Remember to gradually expose and increase your poodle's exposure to the colder weather and don't leave them outside in uncomfortably cold weather for any length of time. Moderate activity and monitor the amount of time they spends outdoors.

Fall is a great time to spend time outdoors with your poodles. Socialize your poodles by taking them for walks in your neighborhood or the park. Most poodles love meeting and greeting pet lovers and pets as much as much as we humans do. This is the time of year when it is generally safe (check the temperature outside) when you can actually enjoy taking your poodles with you on errands without worrying that they are going to get overheated or too cold in the car.
